### Road Safety – Cycle Helmets

Please can we remind you that for those children who ride a bicycle or scooter to school we would highly recommend, that for their own safety, they wear a cycle helmet. A recent study undertaken has found that cycle helmets reduce the risk of:

Head injury by 51%

Serious head injury by 69%

Face injury by 33%

Fatal head injury by 65%

Modern cycle helmets are very light, comfortable and easy to wear. The chances of a bike helmet saving your life, or at least reducing the severity of an injury, are high enough to make it worth wearing one.
