


English

At the start of this half term, the children will continue to read 'The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane'. Once the book is finished, the children will start to read 'Storm' by Kevin Crossley-Holland. The children will be making predictions throughout the story, writing their own poem and creating a book report to try and persuade other children to read the book too.



Maths

Maths will begin with time, looking at years, months, weeks and days as well as hours, minutes and seconds. This will extend into the 24-hour clock and looking at converting to and from this. We will also tackle shape which will look at angles, polygons, triangles and quadrilaterals, as well as lines of symmetry. Finally, we will be looking at charts and graphs, alongside using coordinates and translating coordinates on a grid.

History

This half term we will be learning about Ancient Greece. We will learn about everyday life in Ancient Greece and how their lives have influenced us today. We will undertake research about the Ancient Greeks and create a historical report with our new-found knowledge.



Science

In Science, children will continue learning about living things and their habitats but focusing on conservation. Children will research how ecosystems are affected by the seasons and how human causes can also affect habitats like deforestation and pollution. Children will also learn about ways humans are helping protect habitats and ecosystems.

PSHCE


Our topic this term is 'Changing me'. We will be exploring the changes our body goes through and how we feel about these changes. We will also be learning to understand that we get characteristics from both parents and this makes us unique and special. We will look at how we are feeling moving up to year 5.

The children will explore how Christians show commitment to God and a discussion will be had for the children to think about whether or not all Christians should go to church to show their respect.

Design Technology

In Design Technology, we will be using CAD to design and make a net which can be assembled to hold a product inside. The children will also build upon their skills of planning and evaluating too.



PE

In PE this half term, we will be swimming on a Tuesday morning. The children will need to bring their swimming kits each week. Within these lessons, the children will be learning about water safety and also increase their confidence with completing different swimming strokes.



Music

To understand how music can teach us about different communities and we will continue our recorder lessons with Warwickshire Music.



Spanish

Children will learn how to describe the weather and say what the weather is like in different seasons. They will be able to give a short weather report. We will also learn to give opinions on different ice cream flavours.

Computing

We will look at effective searching through search engines and how to use reliable sources online. Following this, we will look at using electronic music using rhythm, tempo, melody and pitch and create our own electronic piece of music.
