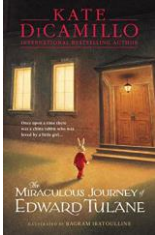


English

In English this half term, the children will be reading 'The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane'. The book is about a China rabbit, who goes on several journeys with different experiences at each. With each journey, he discovers new emotions and finally learns to experience love.



Science

Our topic this half term, is all about living things and their habitats. We will be learning to recognise that living things can be grouped in a variety of ways and use classification keys to help group, identify and name living things in our local and wider environment. Key vocabulary will include: vertebrates, invertebrates, habitat, mammal, reptile, amphibians

Art and Design

In Art, we will be exploring paintings by the American artist, Georgia O'Keefe who is part of modernism. We will be developing our sketching and painting techniques of flowers to create a final painting of a flower in the style of the artist's work.



Maths

In maths, we are looking at decimals: how to understand them on a place value chart, order them, compare them and partition them. We will then be moving on to money: converting between pounds and pence, comparing amount of money, solving problems with money and then on to time. Starting with years, months and days before moving through to looking at a 24-hour clock and converting both to and from this.



Geography

In Geography, we will be exploring the continent of North America and the countries that encompass that continent. We will learn about the climatic variations across North America. We will describe the range of human and physical features across the continent and identify the similarities and differences between these features with



other continents.

PSHCE

Our Jigsaw topic is 'Relationships'. We will be looking at different feelings you can experience within a friendship including 'jealousy'. We will also be exploring the relationships within our family and how it feels to not see people in our families. We will be creating memory boxes about special memories we have shared with our families.

The children will explore how Jews show their commitment to God, comparing their practices in order to explore which shows the most commitment.

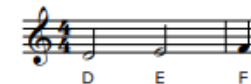
PE
