In reading, we are focusing on our inference skills, understanding words in context and understanding the author's language choice.

Maths

Measurement will focus on area – making shapes, comparing and calculating areas.

In multiplication and division we will be looking at all the multiplications up to 12, looking at division facts, dividing a number by itself and multiplying three numbers. We will also be introducing the children to identifying factors and multiplying by ten and hundred.



History

Anglo Saxons

To investigate why the Anglo Saxons' settlements were built in the way they were after they invaded

To make informed conclusions about the Anglo Saxons' religions.

To compare and contrast the Anglo Saxon era compared to the Stone Age.

PSHCE

Our topic this half term is focusing on bullying and realizing how we make assumptions about people based on appearance. We will also be looking at understanding what makes us special.

Science



In science, we are looking at animals including humans. This includes looking at and identifying the organs in the digestive system, describing the functions of the digestive system, teeth and their functions, understanding the effect of different liquids on teeth and food

PE
