




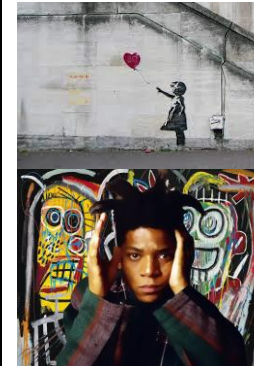

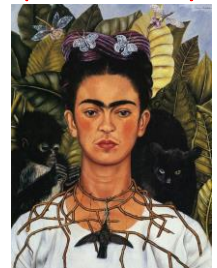

Periods of art (in order):

Renaissance (1400-1600), Baroque (1600-1750), Classical (1750-1827), Romantic (1827-1900), Post-Impressionism (1900-1970), Modernism, Contemporary (1950 onwards)

Within each period – there are different art movements; *Expressionism, Realism, Pop Art, Renaissance and Abstract.*
