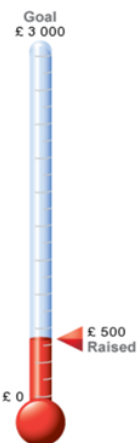
Wasps Rugby visit Year 2

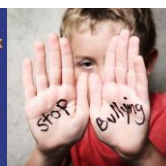
