# **Remote Learning**

## When would my child receive remote learning from school?

If a child is unable to attend due to school closure or a long-term medical condition that prevents them from being in school, school would provide remote education for that child/children.

When a child has to stay off school due to an illness e.g. impetigo, access to remote learning would be decided on a case-by-case basis.

Remote education will not be provided for children who should be in school e.g. absence due to a holiday.

### How will they access remote learning?

- Individual/small group via email e.g. links to websites, worksheets etc.
- If there is a whole school closure for more than one day learning will be provided via teams for Key Stages 1 and 2 and via Seesaw for EYFS.

### How much work would school provide?

This would be dependent on age and stage: Approximately three pieces for EYFS, four pieces for Key Stage 1 and Five pieces for Key Stage 2.

### Resources

Dependent on the amount of pupils, resource can be provided to support. This could be an Ipad, paper, notebooks etc. Parents/Carers would need to collect resources from school. Resources will be provided on a case-by-case basis in discussion with the senior leadership team.
