# English


This half term, the children will start to read 'Storm' by Kevin Crossley-Holland. The children will be making predictions throughout the story, writing their own poem and creating a book report to try and persuade other children to read the book too. We will look in detail at newspaper articles and how these are formed to continue to work on our speech, fronted adverbials and subordinate clauses.

#### Science

Living things and their habitats — conservation. We will be describing how ecosystems are affected by changes in seasons, understanding the impact on the environment through deforestation, air pollution and water pollution and identifying ways that humans can have a positive impact on conservation and nature

# Design Technology

In Design Technology, we will be using CAD to design and make a net which can be assembled to hold a product inside. The children will also build upon their skills of planning and evaluating too.



#### Maths

This half term, we will be looking at shape, statistics and position and direction. This will look specifically at angles, triangles, polygons and quadrilaterals as well as lines of symmetry. This will also include coordinates, plotting on a grid and translation.

We will also be completing our MTC and continuing our times table practice.

This half term we will be learning about Ancient Greece. We will learn about everyday life in Ancient Greece and how their lives have influenced us today. We will undertake research about the Ancient Greeks and create a historical report with our new-found knowledge.
