Please do not add a booking direct to MCAS.

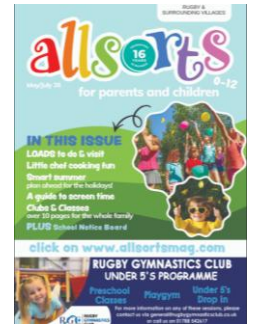
This will ensure that children are attending the correct club on the correct day. Thank you for your support with this.


