

## English

We will use a fictional stimulus in our English lessons. We will develop a range of reading and writing skills linked to our text including, prediction, inference, using a range of sentence structures and writing for a range of purposes.

Within our writing-based lessons, we will continue to embed our Year 5 skills to write a variety of text types: diary entries, letters, speeches, summaries and non-fiction texts.

Within guided reading, we will continue to work on our comprehension skills and develop our stamina for reading whilst focusing on a variety of different texts linked to our history unit and class text.

## Science

This half term we will be focusing on Living Things and their Habitats. Within this unit we will be learning about the life process of a plant and explore lifecycles of mammals, amphibians, reptiles and birds. We will also be focusing on key scientists: Jane Goodall and David Attenborough.

## Art and Design

This half term we will be extending our drawing skills. Our key artist this half term is Han Holbien.

Using different types of sketching pencils to achieve particular effects.

Building up to a final piece: drawing a portrait of a Tudor monarch.

## Maths

### Negative numbers

Understanding what negative numbers are and how they link to everyday life. Solving problems using negative numbers.

### Measurement

This topic will focus on converting units of measure and calculating volume of shapes.

We will also be reading and interpreting timetable.

### Consolidation

We will be focusing on revising year 5 fractions curriculum ready for Year 6.

## History

We will be looking at the Tudors this half term!

This will include looking in further detail at significant events and people during the Tudor period, such as The Battle of Bosworth and the infamous King Henry VIII, Anne Boleyn and the Mary Rose.

We will use our historical skills to critique different artifacts that were once owned by the Tudors.

## PSHCE

Changing Me – we will explore our own self-image and know how to boost our self-esteem. Within this unit we aim to understand changes related to puberty and learn how babies are made.

## RE

This half term we will be continuing with our enquiry question:  
Do religions change or stay the same?
